This bursary fund has been established by the C.U.P.E. PEI Division and affiliated participating locals.

TERMS OF BURSARY:

- (a) The value of the Bursary will be a maximum of \$500.00.
- (b) The selection is to be made by the C.U.P.E. PEI Bursary Committee.
- (c) Application deadline post marked no later than August 31st each year.

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE RECIPIENT:

- (a) Any candidate must be a member in good standing of an affiliated and committed Local to the Bursary Fund of the Division
- (b) Or, a candidate must be the spouse, daughter or son (adopted or natural) of a member in good standing of an affiliated and committed Local to the Bursary Fund, of the Division.
- (c) Any candidate must be enrolled in an academic or vocational education program (anywhere and not limited to P.E.I. institutions)
- (d) Any candidate must show, to the satisfaction of the Committee that he/she is intent on furthering his/her education in his/her chosen field
